### **What is C3 Conference?**

C3 Conference is a unique opportunity for high school students where they will develop a personal plan for spiritual growth, as well as develop a "student action plan" for their school. This plan serves to unite the interests and vision of each school's student team, develop the ideas they have interacted with during the conference, and challenge them to impact their school through a specific project, program or event during the months following C3.

### **What are the GOALS of C3 Conference?**

- To help its participants (students and chaperones alike) grow in their personal walk with Christ and in their commitment to serving God.
- To help Christian student leaders identify leadership skills and potentials that God has placed in them for His purposes and for their benefit.
- To help students recognize God's call on their lives to lead now while preparing to lead in the future, impacting their world for Christ.
- To guide students in developing a personal plan for growth.
- To strengthen the students' structure of support through building community in the school's student leadership team and between schools of different countries and languages within a setting of love and Christian grace and fellowship.
- To strengthen Christian schools through the commitment and service of those students who participate in the C3 event.
- To strengthen a concept of mentoring and discipleship of students for chaperones.

### **Who should attend?**

- Students entering grades 9-12 who:
  - desire to grow in their understanding and "living out" of the Great Commission
  - want to be transformed by Christ's compassion for the world
  - want to discover God's calling on their lives both now (in school) and in the future (however God will use them)
  - are willing to take action and initiative in their schools to walk alongside others and lead them towards Jesus

## **Travel**

### *ON-ISLAND ATTENDEES*

You will receive an email with the departure time closer to the conference date.

### *OFF-ISLAND ATTENDEES*

Transportation from the airport to the camp location (~2.5 hours by bus) is included in the cost of registration and will be arranged after your registration form is submitted. The preferred airport is Taipei (TPE).

**Arrival:** Attendees should ideally plan to arrive at TPE before 2:00 PM on August 5 to allow sufficient time to reach the venue for the first scheduled event.

**Departure:** Attendees should plan to depart from TPE on August 9, after 1:00 PM if possible, to allow sufficient time to transfer from the camp back to the airport.
